Learn how to do a cost-benefit analysis for your water project. Trainers from the Conservation Strategy Fund will be here to introduce economic fundamentals and basic steps and strategies for incorporating cost-benefit analysis into project proposals and decisions. Participants will learn about assessing the economic feasibility of small-scale and large-scale projects, including incorporation of environmental goods and services, and will have the opportunity to discuss how cost-benefit analysis could be applied to their specific projects using the CA Department of Water Resource's cost-benefit analysis approaches. Participants will leave the workshop with an essential foundation in some basic economic concepts and language, and a strategy for formulating economic justifications for their projects.
