

Regional Water Management Group (RWMG): Primary decision-making body of the Inyo-Mono IRWM Program. Made up of signatories to the IRWM Program Memorandum of Understanding. Provides direction to the Administrative Committee and Program Office.

Administrative Committee (AC): Made up of six RWMG Members elected on a rotating basis, this Committee provides guidance to the Program Office, oversees activities of fiscal agents/grantees, and assists with preparing annual financial report for the RWMG.

Program Office: Performs the day-to-day operations of the IRWM Program. These duties include:

- Preparing for, facilitating, and following up on RWMG meetings
- Attending meetings with stakeholders, potential stakeholders, governing boards, DWR
- Updating and reporting to AC, RWMG, and DWR
- Primary point of contact for RWMG and AC
- Updating and maintenance of IRWM Plan
- Preparation of funding proposals
- Outreach and fundraising
- Maintaining current information to the public via media, meetings, website
- Data management
- Other duties as directed or needed

Fiscal agent/Grantee: Entity(ies) that apply for IRWM grants and provide grant administration services throughout the project.

California Department of Water Resources (DWR): Operates and maintains IRWM Grant Program and distributes funding to IRWM regions.

RCAC and CRWA: provide technical, managerial, and financial (TMF) assistance to small, rural, and/or disadvantaged community water systems. The Inyo-Mono RWMG has worked extensively with CRWA to provide needs assessments and technical assistance in the region. RCAC has not been very heavily involved in the region, at least through the IRWM process.

SGMA, OVGA, JPA: Programs and entities focused on groundwater management in the Owens Valley. The requirements of SGMA did not expressly include interactions with corresponding IRWM regions. The Inyo-Mono RWMG is working with the OVGA to determine how best to be involved in the process.
